What to do if someone is ill in your household?

	 Individual must get a test (or ring 111 for further advice if you're unsure) Whole household needs to isolate until outcome of test is known Inform school at the earliest opportunity and keep us informed daily 	
Member of household has symptoms	POSITIVE TEST RESULT Individual isolates for 10 days from when symptoms started Household isolates for 14 days from when symptoms started Track and trace may request isolation for other close contacts Pupil returns to school on 15 th day unless they still have a high temperature	Isolation ends for individual, pupil and entire household Pupil returns to school unless they have developed any of the symptoms of coronavirus, in which case follow the 'Pupil has symptoms' guidance above.
DO NOT	 <u>Do not</u> return to school after isolation if you still have a high temperature <u>Do not</u> get a test or remain off school if you don't have coronavirus symptoms (e.g. you only have a sore throat, headache or cold symptoms) <u>Do not</u> send your child to school if they do not feel well enough to be at school (regardless of whether they have coronavirus symptoms or not)
