Dear Parent / Carer,

Residential Trip – (Bristol Residential) Date: (24th June – 28th June 2019) Year (5)

During the summer term, your child will be studying the differences and similarities between Wimborne and Bristol alongside British Shipping 1837 – 1937.

The trip is a residential one, staying two nights in the Youth Hostel, which is situated in the city centre. The location is ideal for visiting the Explore Science museum (a hands on experience), SS Great Britain, and many sight-seeing tours which include a pirate walk and a harbour ferry trip.

We understand that your child may be concerned about staying away from home at this age; however, we really focus on the social aspects of the trip – sharing rooms with their friends, working with new children, and team building/ co-operation skills. They will be supervised by the Year 5 staff and we find that the children are so busy having fun that they cope especially well with being away from home. To help prepare them for their trip, nearer the time we give a talk about what they will be doing whilst away and answer all their questions. In addition, we have an evening for parents where you will be able to find out more.

The trip has been planned for the week of **24th June 2019**. The children will be organised into two groups:

Group 1 – 24th June – 26th June

Group 2 – 26th June – 28th June

During the Spring term, the children will be organised into groups and you will be notified as to which days your child will be visiting Bristol as well as given more information on the parent meeting that will take place prior to the trip.

The total cost for the trip will be £140. I have attached the following breakdown that should be paid through Parent mail:

Deposit of £50 – to be paid to confirm place by 31st January 2019, followed by 3 instalments of £30:

1st instalment due 28/2/2019	£30
2nd Instalment due 31/3/2019	£30
3rd Instalment due 30/04/2019	£30
Total	£140




