The Doric chiton was usually made of wool. It was folded in half lengthways and folded over the top. It was fastened at the shoulder with brooches.

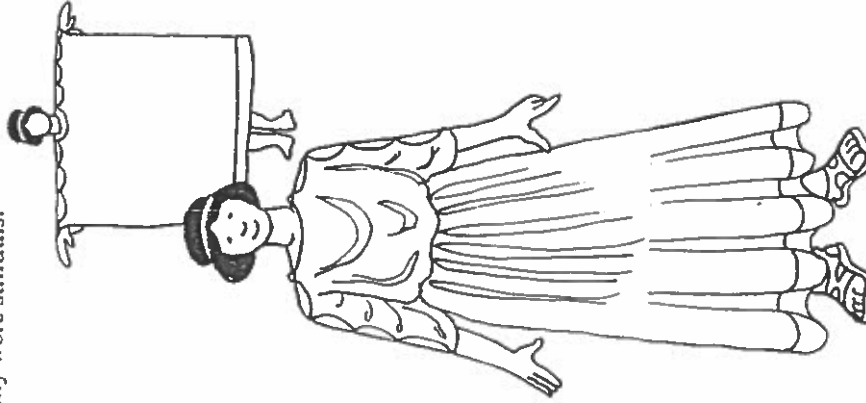
Both men and women usually wore sandals.

Colour the sandals brown.



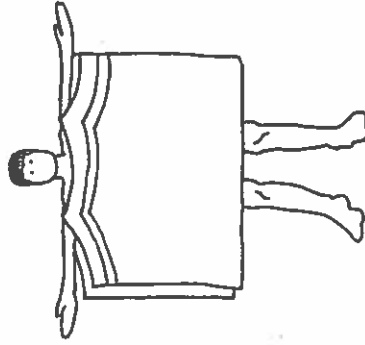

A himation was a kind of cloak worn wrapped round the body with or without a tunic underneath.
